It was beautiful to see parents/carers onsite last week at our first assembly. Our new Junior School Councillors and School Captains set a very high standard to ensure a very slick event each week. Thank you, everyone, and well done.

Some exciting news is that we are planning to allow parents/carers onsite to drop off and pick up inside the school grounds very soon, so stay tuned for more information as we work through the logistics.

Typically, Melbourne has turned on hot weather for February, but thankfully the nights are cooler. To cope better with Melbourne's ever-changing weather, we are in the process of upgrading our air conditioning and heating systems across the whole school, which are long overdue and nearly as old as the school! This will make things much more comfortable for everyone.

School Council are working on some other big-ticket building and grounds projects for this year. These include student toilet upgrades, creating an undercover outside area of our SAKG kitchen, adding an automated security gate to the staff car park, and renovating the staff room and reception to include new office space for the Business Manager. In addition, we are looking into a major revamp of our junior playground area and will be inviting parents for feedback/ideas on the design in the upcoming months.

COVID is still playing a big part in our school life. We have air purifiers throughout the school and our usual COVID safe practices in place. The distribution of the Rapid Antigen Tests has also been a success. Unfortunately, several students have tested positive, but thankfully there haven't been any cluster outbreaks as a result. All positive cases will continue to be reported via Compass to keep our community up-to-date and aware of developments. Please note that we do not conduct any testing or administer vaccinations on site.

Wellbeing is high on the agenda for the school alongside teaching and learning. To further support this, we have timetabled all teams to regularly meet and plan, including a specific time when staff will monitor student attendance. Chloe Gerada is coordinating these meetings as our new Student Engagement Learning Specialist. In addition, we have appointed a new Attendance Officer, Stacey Kakalis, who will start in 3 weeks to provide administration assistance.

Teacher quality is the most important in-school factor influencing student achievement. However, the relationship between teacher quality and student achievement is affected by the amount of time students spend in the classroom. Therefore, irrespective of the reasons for absences, non-attendance affects student outcomes.

Protecting the safety and wellbeing of children through the reporting and monitoring of absenteeism is the responsibility of both parents/carers and schools. Please remember to log your child's absence on Compass to keep accurate records and keep everyone safe. Alternatively, call the school on 9404 1362 or email at findon.ps@education.vic.gov.au if your child will be away or late for school.

Clear communication and building a positive and collaborative relationship between schools and parents is critical to successfully implementing same-day notifications. Therefore, our school will contact you as soon as practicable if a student is not at school and you haven't notified the school.

If we cannot reach you, we will contact any emergency contact/s nominated on your child's file held by the school, where possible, on the same day of the unexplained absence.

Please remember it is your responsibility to contact us to explain your child's absence from school, and where possible, please inform us in advance of upcoming absences.

On a lighter note, next week my daughter is getting married. As the Mother Of The Bride, I will be taking some personal leave, and Linda Dimos will be Acting Principal in my absence. Fingers crossed, there won't be any sudden changes in COVID restrictions. We've made it this far!
