What is the BYOD Program?



The BYOD Program has been put in place to allow all students in Year 3 to learn flexibly by bringing in their own device to use at school and at home.

What's happened to the Netbook Program?

The Netbook Program has been a huge success at Findon Primary School over the past 12 years, however, with the changes previously rolled out to schools in regards to Parent Payments, the old Netbook Program cannot be sustained. Students that are already on the existing Netbook Program will continue to run as usual, with the inclusion of the option to Bring Your Own Device. From 2024, students entering the program can join by bringing in an <u>eligible</u> device from home.

What If I don't have a device?

If you don't have a device, you have two options if you'd like to join the BYOD Program:

- Purchase a device from a retailer
- Purchase or Finance a device through our LWT online portal (Link below)

If your device meets the minimum device specifications, you're welcome to use it.



MINIMUM DEVICE SPECIFICATIONS

Findon Primary School requires devices with the following minimum specifications

Windows Devices:

Windows 10
Intel Celeron or better
128GB SSD
4GB RAM
11.6" Screen
8 Hour Battery Life
Physical Keyboard

Mac Laptops:

Must be a 2020 model or newer macOS Sonoma (14.0) or later 128GB SSD 4GB RAM

Chromebooks:

Must be less than 3 years old
Intel Celeron or better
32GB SSD
4GB RAM
11.6" Screen
8 Hour Battery Life
Physical Keyboard

<u>iPads</u>:

Must be less than 4 years old iPad (8th Gen) or newer iPad Mini (6th Gen) or newer iPad Air (4th Gen) or newer iPad Pro (5th Gen) or newer

Android Tablets are <u>not</u> permitted

Do I have to buy a device from LWT?

No, you can buy a device from any retailer (or bring one you already own).
Though the device <u>MUST</u> meet our <u>minimum device</u> specifications.

Can I bring an Android Tablet?

No, Android Tablets are not currently supported on the BYOD Program. Not all Android devices are compatible with our School Network as some manufacturers don't include the necessary functionality required to connect to our type of network.

What happens if my device gets damaged?

Netbooks brought to school for the BYOD program will not be covered if damages occur.

We can assist in diagnosing physical issues, but we can only fix software issues. Damage (cracked screens, broken plastics etc.) will **NOT** be covered or insured by the school.
